## Southern Nazarene University R.T. Williams Library, Bethany, OK

Project Manager and Lead Designer

For this dated and underused building, I created a space for students to gather, be at leisure, and connect to campus support staff. I designed an exterior canopy to better orient the building to its surroundings and be an inviting beacon drawing in students. By adding a gathering space and café and relocating administrative offices to the library, this building has become a campus hub.

## Southern Nazarene University Webster Commons, Bethany, OK

For this dining facility renovation, my goal was to enhance the student dining experience and create an environment that encouraged community. The transformation provided an updated atmosphere that achieved its goal of keeping students on campus for dining.

# Southern Nazarene University J.D. and Mary West Science Laboratory, Bethany, OK Interior Designer

This 26,600 square foot university science facility houses biology and chemistry laboratories, several research labs, and ancillary support spaces. Through an open floor plan and heavy implementation of observation windows on interior walls, I sought to create an environment where science felt accessible. I collaborated on the design of the exterior curtain wall system that mimics a helix, designing the detailed connections that allow the wall to gently articulate, symbolizing the work done within.

## Bethany First Church of the Nazarene Sanctuary Renovation, Bethany, OK

Project Manager and Lead Designer

Remodeled a 1960s building with deteriorating finishes and antiquated equipment, providing an updated and more intimate experience for the congregation. The project included a complete overhaul of all theatrical equipment; a stage expansion; and new seating, lighting, and finishes.

## The Halls Pizza Kitchen, Oklahoma City, OK

Project Manager and Lead Designer

A tire factory previously occupied this Midtown district historic renovation of a 1920s industrial warehouse. Beginning with a structurally compromised shell, the building was reinforced to add a rooftop terrace that allows for seating with views of downtown and rooftop gardening. A commercial kitchen with an exposed wood-fire pizza oven is the focal point of the dining room.

## City of Woodward City Hall, Woodward, OK

Project Manager and Lead Designer

This small-town, Main Street City Hall involved incorporating adjoining buildings, one built in the 1960s as a bank and the other a 1920s movie theater. This adaptive reuse project resulted in the relocation of all city offices to a single building.

## The Hill at Bricktown, Oklahoma City, OK

Interior Designer

These urban townhomes are in the Deep Deuce district of Oklahoma City. Here, I assisted with creating multi-level floorplans designed to meet fair housing requirements for accessibility and helped with construction administration.

## Mid-America Christian University Dining Facility, Oklahoma City, OK

Project Manager and Lead Designer

This renovation encouraged on-campus dining for both resident and commuter students, promoting a sense of community. A new food service program expanded food offerings, and the redesign showcased those offerings to create an engaging environment in the expanded dining room.

## Mid-America Christian University Science Laboratory, Oklahoma City, OK

Project Manager and Interior Designer

The design retrofits a science laboratory and autoclave in an existing classroom space. New testing equipment, fume hoods, chemical storage, and mechanical and electrical upgrades were carefully organized to create an all-purpose location for the biology and chemistry departments. I coordinated closely with the laboratory consultant and mechanical and electrical engineers to allow for increased loads on the building.

## Southern Plaza Retirement Center, Bethany, OK

Interior Designer

The design includes adding a building for sixty-six assisted living units and twenty-six memory care units, with a four-story storm shelter to accommodate the entire population of Southern Plaza. The expansion's interiors were designed with the input of residents and staff to create a real home away from home.

## Bethany Public Schools Early Childhood Center and Storm Shelter, Bethany, OK

Interior Designer

This 9,067 square foot Early Childhood Center incorporates two storm shelters, a cafeteria, classrooms, and an outdoor playground. Space planning, finishes, and lighting were developed in coordination with teachers and engineers.

#### Bethany Public Schools S.T.E.M. Building, Bethany, OK

Interior Designer

This project was part of the 2015 Bethany Public Schools bond issue. The building provides the school with a new space to support its S.T.E.M. programs for middle and high school students.

#### Bethany Public Schools Performing Arts Center, Bethany, OK

Interior Designer

The project is an expansion of the existing performing arts center. The new design allows for additional seating, a stage expansion, and the installation of a fly loft. New technology, equipment, seating, and finishes were designed to enhance the viewer experience.

## Oklahoma City Church of the Nazarene Cole Community Center, Oklahoma City, OK

The new facility boasts a 10,000 square foot multi-purpose gymnasium and banquet space, and a large kitchen to serve over 700 guests. The interiors incorporate locker rooms, public gathering spaces, and classrooms.
