Accreditation

The University of Oklahoma Master of Landscape Architecture (M.L.A.) is a professional program and is fully accredited by the LAAB. The First Professional Master of Landscape Architecture is for students who do not have a previous professional degree in landscape architecture and who may come from fields as diverse as English literature, drama, wildlife management or nursing. The Post Professional Master of Landscape Architecture is only for students who have completed an accredited professional degree in landscape architecture and desire a design or research focus in a specialized area.

According to department records, graduates of our program have historically secured entry-level positions in landscape architecture or a related field at above average national rates.
