The panelists of this symposium addressed key issues from environmental racism and marine conservation to the crucial role of Indigenous communities as front leaders of the environment. The symposium was a Global South and Indigenous-focused climate awareness event. It offered an opportunity for panelists to advocate for communities that need critical attention and for attendees to challenge common misconceptions about the current climate crisis. The symposium was a CPD and SIC collaboration, supported by a grant from the Carnegie Corporation of New York.
